If you are in your 70's, then make plans to join me on Tuesday, August 20th at 6:00 pm.


And, if you are 80 or above, then we'll have dinner on Wednesday, August 21st at 6:00 pm.



Memorial Garden

The Board of Trustees have been exploring the potential of installing a Memorial Garden here at Wrightsville UMC. A memorial garden provides a peaceful and serene space for church members to remember, and honor loved ones who have passed away. It can be a place for reflection and prayer, creating a place of connection to loved ones.

A memorial garden invites community into the sacred space of the church, strengthening the bond between both. The church becomes the place where families come together in grief, where individuals seek solace in loss, and communities gather in remembrance.

To be able to place a loved one's ashes where the person worshiped and many of his or her milestones in life happened is quite significant – where one was married, raised their children, was baptized, grew in their faith, created lifelong friendships, and finally, where the loved one's life was celebrated upon death. To be able to either scatter or inter the loved one's ashes at their church is something that many people want to do.

The Memorial Garden will be located on the south edge of the church campus right by the Chapel. It will include a brick wall the length of the property with Columbaria, which is storage for cremated remains (cremains) of a deceased person. Each niche in the Columbaria will hold the human cremains of one or two people. There will be a granite faceplate on each niche that will be engraved with the occupant's name(s), date(s) of birth and death. In addition, there will be a designated area of the Memorial Garden for the scattering or burying of cremated ashes. There will be a Memorial Plaque that will include the names of the individuals whose ashes have been scattered in the garden and another Memorial Plaque to honor the memory of family members buried elsewhere.

Our next step for the creation of the Memorial Garden will be getting the Town of Wrightsville Beach's approval by adding an ordinance to the Town's codes. Upon the ToWB's approval, reservations for niches, placement in the scattering garden, or name on the Memorial Plaque will begin. Hopefully that will be this fall – stay tuned! In the meantime, we hope to see you on July 28!




